 - Brought up All County Broadcast (ACB) Policy 3.03 that was discussed in LE Police Chiefs Committee. Passed out and talked about needed review of Policy 3.03 and how the policy wasn't necessarily being best utilized across the county. Discussion settled around the need for a small but concise list of ACBs that could help aid Police Chief Committee concerns and could be utilized effectively and efficiently across all PSAPs. Discussed the possibility of ACB that would overtake the primary channels of LE agencies for extreme emergencies such as Officer Needs Assistance and Active Shooter calls. PSAP Committee will be reviewing the policy and reporting back.

- PSAP Mgr. John Meyer opened discussion on Hot-Mic when E-Button pressed based on a recent incident with a plain clothes officer who did not have a shoulder mic. Current Policy 4.05.3 refers to Hot-Mic settings with 4.05.5 currently defining current hot-mic Talkgroups for Corrections and School Emergency. This will be added to Old Business discussion for further extending Hot-Mic Talkgroups.
- Advisory Board participant Lt. Geoff Robinson from Oxford PD opened discussion on Drone Naming
 Conventions and Drone Standards with better ways to utilize and communicate Drone info over the Radio
 System. This is being added to Old Business for further discussion and a potential new policy for Drone
 Standards.




