## BRICS SYSTEM UPDATES

- Capt. Franke / Dir. K. Carpenter
  - Presented by Mgr. Brian Stiens
  - > BS-PTT's coincide with last year's numbers, no busys. KC-Numbers are coming up
  - ➤ BS-21 radios sent to depot YTD, currently 4 out for repair. MF-Are radios that we send able to be fixed? BS-Yes. Discussion of radio swap with KC
  - > BS-Financial, a little over \$2700 in open invoices, not including recent TSD purchase.
  - ➤ BS-XT series, notification bulletin was sent to subscribers about July 1, 2025 cutoff. List of agencies still using XT series was presented. JJ-Any feedback from users? KC-Had three ask about upgrade, showed tech bulletins from the past, users should have been aware. Brief discussion followed.
  - > BS-System Updates, LED upgrades & HVAC replacement progress and schedule discussed

  - JJ-Ryan was representing Hospital Committee? PW-Yes
  - > JJ-Asks Ron if he will be representing on that committee. RH-Yes

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

- **PSAP,** Dir. D. Dick
  - > DD-PSAP Committee met, had police & fire chief's at meeting. Discussed use of Ch 16 (Pursuit 16) & making it a common talk group across Law & Fire (act like a TAC). Use for fire & law entering a warm or hot zone and rescue taskforces. MF-Asks about purpose, sounds like TACs already.
  - DD-Have it in A Zone, benefits Law as they don't change Zones as often as Fire. Discussion follows.
  - > JJ-For active situations. This is start of discussions, need to get communications involved. Lengthy discussion follows among members.
  - > DD-PSAP also discussed ACB and continued push to use them. MF-Consoles checked and are set for ACB.

- PW-At Motorola software engineer level. Discussion of APX 4000 issue among members.
- JM-Asks about weather radio re-broadcast over school radios. Discussion follows. JJ-TSD radios, explains usage and interface with public safety as part of alerting for schools & school radios

- JJ-New meeting schedule and dates. Moved to quarterly meetings.
- MF-Establish months and days. Does current days and times still work? New days or times needed? Discussion follows. January, April, July & October, same day and time. The next meeting is January 25, 2024.
- DR-Discusses recent training issue, an agency was on a LAW channel instead of a Training channel. Discussion of issue among members. MF-Discusses Training Zone in radios and agencies requesting 205's. KC-Lots of agencies are unaware of Training Zone and usage. May include it in video trainings.

- MF, DD discuss use of 205's and training.
